Self-Tinted Liquid-Applied Products

What Is The Concern?

Self-tinted liquid-applied products... tinted outside of GAF factories will no longer be eligible for coverage under GAF's system and product warranties.

- This includes, but is not limited to, products tinted at:
 - Paint stores
 - Home improvement stores
 - Independent dealers/distributors

Why Can't I Self-Tint My Liquid-Applied Product?

Self-tinting any liquid-applied product is NOT a minor change... especially in accent or pastel bases.

- GAF cannot control what colorants are used or how they may affect product performance.
- Colorants can negatively affect the performance of the product in a number of ways, including:
 - Fire rating
 - Dirt pick-up
 - Waterproofing
 - Color fastness
 - Other physical properties
- Incompatible colorants may cause a product to gel.

How Can I Get A Tinted Liquid-Applied Product That Is Eligible For Coverage Under GAF's Warranties?

To request tinted liquid-applied products that may be eligible for system or product warranties... contact GAF Customer Services at (877-423-7663). There is a **50-gallon minimum** order for a custom color. A list of GAF standard colors is also available for standard colors that do not require a minimum order quantity. GAF recommends applying a color sample to an inconspicuous area on the actual substrate to verify color choice.

Note: This does **NOT** apply to StreetBond® Pavement Coatings with GAF approved colorants.
